

Starter (P4-P5) (DBS) Ages 9-10	To kickstart students' combined ability to think and articulate, our starter debate class aims to inspire the next generation of young debaters. Level 1 (P6-S1) (DB1) Ages 11-12	This level of debate class introduces the world of competitive debate to budding speakers through interactive group work and constant feedback from our coaches. Level 2 (S2-S3) (DB2) Ages 13-14	Formal debate skills are honed to shape orators at this stage. Level 3 (S4+) (DB3) Ages 15+	Four competing teams in a round, live-fire interjection during a speech or sharp questions from the floor.
